RULES FOR ADMISSION OF INDIVIDUALS TO STUDY PROGRAMMS IN FOREIGN LANGUAGES IN 2022

CHAPTER I
GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Rules for Admission (hereinafter – the Rules) of individuals intending to study in foreign languages (hereinafter – the individuals) the first-cycle university study programmes not financed by the state at Klaipeda State University of Applied Sciences (hereinafter - the University) establish the general principles and procedures for the admission of individuals with at least secondary education.
2. In 2022 admission to the University is carried out in accordance with the documentation of the Minister of Education, Science and Sport of the Republic of Lithuania (hereinafter - LR ŠMSM) regulating admission to the study programs in foreign languages for higher education institutions.¹
3. The rules for admission of individuals to the University in 2022 provide only additional information, which may be accordingly revised considering any changes of the legal acts of the Republic of Lithuania.
4. Admission is carried out by the International Relations Department of the University (hereinafter - TRS). The results of the admission are approved by the Admission Commission formed by the order of the Director on the recommendation of the Head of TRS. The protocol is the basis of the order on the admission of students to study. A study agreement is signed with the student in two copies, one of which belongs to the student, the other is kept in the student's file at the University. The study contract is the basis for payment for studies.
5. In all cases not provided for in the admission rules, decisions shall be taken by the Admissions Committee.

CHAPTER II
REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATIONS

6. Individuals intending to study the University study programmes in foreign languages must submit the following documents:
 - 6.1. online application and motivation letter www.apply.kvk.lt;
 - 6.2. passport copy, notarised;

- 6.3. copies of documents certifying education (these documents must be submitted with a certified translation into English, Lithuanian or Russian), notarized;
- 6.4. proof of payment of the non-refundable accession fee (EUR 120);
- 6.5. a valid document certifying the foreign language proficiency level (TOEFL, IELTS, etc.) (the minimum required proficiency level of a foreign language - B1). Does not apply to individuals whose first language is English or who has a previous education in English.
 - 6.5.1. In case the individual does not have this document, employee of the University performs the foreign language proficiency test remotely. The individual is informed about the method and time of determining the level of the foreign language.
 - 6.5.2. If proficiency level of a foreign language of an individual is lower than required, he/she may be admitted to studies provided he/she achieves the required language proficiency level during the first semester of studies.
- 6.6. documents proving the activities performed, as required for the calculation of the additional score (in accordance with the item 2.1 of the Rules).
7. Good quality, clearly legible, colourful copies of the required documents are placed on the e-portal www.apply.kvk.lt or sent by e-mail admissions@kvk.lt, if the entrant's documents are submitted by an authorized person.
8. The University reserves the right to request submission of original or notarized copies required for the academic recognition of qualifications acquired abroad in accordance with “Guidelines of the procedure for assessment of education and qualifications concerning higher education and acquired under educational programmes of foreign states and international organizations for those applying to study at Klaipeda State University of Applied Sciences” (hereinafter – guidelines for academic recognition)² approved by University Directors order no. V1-022 as of 15th February 2022.
9. If a foreign qualification is not recognized, admission to the University is not granted and the individual is notified immediately.

CHAPTER III STRUCTURE OF THE COMPETITIVE SCORE

10. A minimum competitive score of **4.3** is applied to all entrants to non-state funded study places in 2022.
11. The structure of the competitive score for individuals according to the study programmes:

CHAPTER V ADMISSION DATES AND PROCESSES IN 2022

15. Admission is carried out in two stages: first, the documents submitted are assessed in accordance with Chapter II. If the documents are submitted, an academic assessment of the foreign qualification is carried out in accordance with the guidelines of academic recognition.
16. TRS informs the individual who have submitted applications by email about the decision made on admission to study.
17. The individual pays a one-year tuition fee. Upon a reasoned request, a person may pay the tuition fee in instalments.
18. TRS prepares and sends the mediation documents for the visa (if necessary) to the recipient only after receiving the documents confirming the payment for the studies.

19. The fact of study is confirmed by signing the study agreement, the protocol for the Admission Commission and the order of the Director regarding admission to studies are prepared, the student file is compiled and forwarded to the Center for Studies and Career.
20. Admission will not be carried out if:
- 20.1. the individual does not submit all the documents in time;
 - 20.2. copies of submitted documents are not of good quality;
 - 20.3. the admission deadline passed.

22. Prior to the commencement of studies, a person may terminate studies by submitting a request to TRS in the prescribed form. If the request for termination of the study agreement is not submitted in time, the agreement shall be deemed valid.
23. All individuals submitting an application for studies pay an application fee of 120 Eur. The registration fee is non-refundable.
