2. Requirements and additional information

2.1. Recommended language skills

Following the agreement with our institution, the sending institution is responsible for ensuring that nominated candidates possess the necessary language skills at the start of their study or teaching period.

At Haliç University, we offer both fully English and fully Turkish programs. Therefore:

- Students who are nominated to study in a **fully English-taught department** are required to have at least a **minimum B1 level of English**. This must be proven through an **official language certificate** or a **formal letter issued by their home university** confirming their language proficiency.
- Similarly, students who wish to study in a **fully Turkish-taught department** must provide proof of at least **B1 level Turkish** through a certificate or an official university-issued document.

This requirement is important to ensure students can successfully participate in academic activities and benefit from their mobility experience. Please refer to our course catalogue for more details on the language of instruction recommendations. The language requirements may be different for some subject areas.

2.2. Guidelines

- Students must be **officially nominated by their home universities** by sending an email to **erasmus@halic.edu.tr**
- Once the nomination is received, our team will send a **confirmation message** to the sending institution. After the **nomination deadline** has passed, we will **contact the nominated students directly** and provide them with all the necessary information regarding the application process and next steps.
- In case of **additional requirements** regarding academic, organizational, or other aspects (e.g., students with special needs), please contact us at **erasmus@halic.edu.tr**
- Incoming students are allowed to take courses from different study fields; however, their Erasmus
 departmental coordinator will be assigned based on the majority (density) of the courses they
 choose.
- Erasmus+ students (KA131) can submit their **Learning Agreement (LA)** digitally via **EWP**, or alternatively as a **scanned copy** if their home institution has not yet implemented the EWP system.

- Students are offered a Turkish language course throughout the semester.
- Academic staff interested in a teaching visit at HU should contact the relevant department.
- Non-academic staff members interested in spending a training week at HU should contact erasmus@halic.edu.tr. A proposal of the Mobility Agreement and CV are also required.

2.3.1. Nomination and Application Deadlines

- Halic University receive nominations via email.
- Nominations and applications must reach our institution by:

2.3.2. Decision Response

• Successful students should receive the Letter of Acceptance within 2 weeks after the application deadline via email. An approved LA is a condition for acceptance.

2.3.3. Arrival Dates and Orientation

- The students should plan their arrival for the weekend preceding the beginning of the Orientation Week
- All students are expected to attend the Orientation programme. Dates and details of the Orientation Week are confirmed by email once the students have been accepted.

2.3.4. Transcripts of Records

• A Transcript of Records will be issued no later than 4 weeks after the assessment period has finished at our institution. The student will download it in the Haliç University OBS System. If a hard copy is needed, the student has to contact the International Relations Coordination Office.

3.2. Number of courses/credits per semester

- Normal workload is 30 ECTS per semester.
- There is no minimum or maximum ECTS requirement for incoming students; they are free to choose courses according to their academic needs and the approval of their home departments.
- Erasmus International Credit mobility (KA171) students and all exchange students are required to take min 30 ECTS per semester.

4.1. Residence Permit

• Students who come to study at **Haliç University** must apply for a **residence permit for students** after their arrival in **Istanbul**.

• During this procedure, the **International Relations Coordination Office** provides assistance and guidance to all incoming students, ensuring they are well-informed and supported throughout the application process.

4.2. Insurance

- All incoming students are required to have valid health insurance that is recognized in Turkey and covers the entire duration of their stay.
- The insurance policy must clearly include a **policy number** and provide **comprehensive medical coverage** during the mobility period.
- Students are responsible for arranging their health insurance after their arrival in Istanbul.
