CHALLENGES IN THE GREEN TRANSITION

- **Skills gap:** A shortage of workers trained in energy retrofiting, environmental monitoring, and green tech.
- **Territorial inequality:** Northern regions are ahead in the circular economy; Southern regions lag.
- **Land-use tensions:** Restrictions on ground-mounted solar conflict with agricultural land protection.
- **Dependence on fossil fuels.**



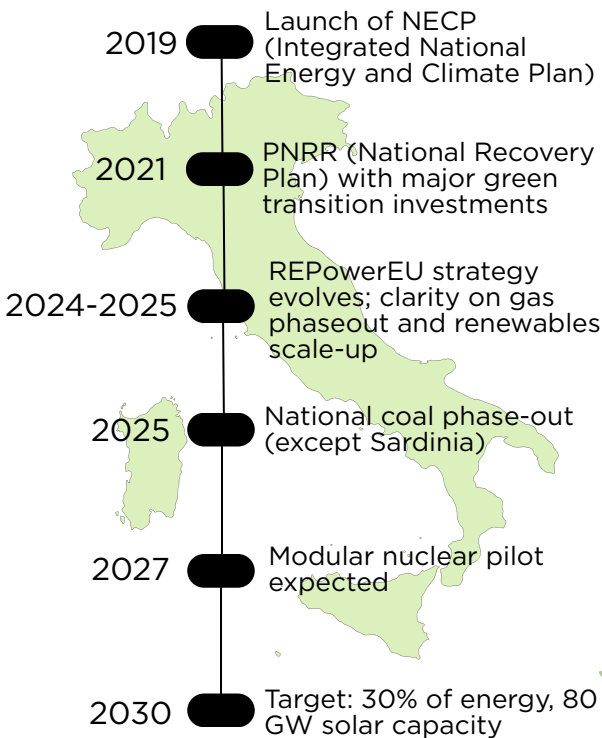
OPPORTUNITIES



- **Renewables boom** (2030 targets: 30% of total energy from renewables, 55% of electricity from renewables)
- **Strong PNRR funding:** €16.9B for building upgrades, €34.5B for sustainable mobility, €24.7B for renewables and circular economy.
- **Circular economy leadership:** €1.5B dedicated to modernizing waste infrastructure, +6.8 GW of solar installed in 2024
- **Green Jobs & Skills:** 117,000 green jobs per year are expected by 2030, 4.4 million job roles will require green skills in 2025 (~80% of all hires)
