### PROMOTE TRANSNATIONAL COOPERATION

by fostering methodologies and synergies between education, research, and labor market stakeholders to address global challenges in green entrepreneurship.

### ENHANCE SOCIAL INCLUSION AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES

by empowering DHH learners with skills to lead sustainable initiatives and participate actively in the green economy, ensuring no one is left behind.



### SUPPORT AND PROMOTE EU PRIORITIES

such as the Green Deal, the Skills Agenda, and the Disability Strategy, aligning project outcomes with broader goals of sustainability, digital transformation, and inclusivity.
