GreenEntre4Deaf Launches Its International Training Programme

The **GreenEntre4Deaf** project is entering an important phase with the implementation of its **Transnational Professional Training Programme for Higher Education Educators and Trainers**, designed to strengthen the capacity of professionals working with **Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) learners** in the field of **green entrepreneurship education**.

As part of the project's commitment to promoting **inclusive teaching, digital innovation and green skills development**, the training programme combines online and face-to-face learning opportunities aimed at familiarising educators with the innovative resources developed by the consortium and preparing them for their future use in educational settings.

An Introductory Online Session to Launch the Training Journey

The training pathway officially started on **11 June 2026** with an online introductory session attended by educators and trainers from all partner countries. During the meeting, participants were introduced to the overall objectives of the **GreenEntre4Deaf project**, its partnership and its main results and deliverables.

The session also provided an overview of the project's **Syllabus** and the four modules that make up the **Modularised Course: Foundations of Environmental Science, Understanding Green Entrepreneurship, Building an Enterprise, and Becoming a Deaf Entrepreneur**. Participants had the opportunity to explore the educational structure behind the training programme and gain a first understanding of the learning objectives associated with each module.

A practical component was also included through the testing and assessment of the project's **e-entrepreneurship mobile application**, allowing participants to provide valuable feedback before the upcoming international mobility. The session concluded with a presentation of the training activities to be carried out in Cyprus and a discussion of participants' expectations for the next stage of the programme.

International Training Mobility in Cyprus

The core of the training programme will take place during the **Transnational Training Mobility** hosted in **Nicosia, Cyprus, on 30 June and 1 July 2026**. Over two intensive days, participants will engage with the project's main educational and digital resources.

The programme includes the presentation of the **Green Entrepreneurship Sign Language Competence Framework**, a key project aimed at supporting accessible entrepreneurship education through specialised terminology and communication tools. Participants will also explore the project's **online learning platform**, including its functionalities, navigation features and user profile creation process.

A significant part of the mobility will be dedicated to hands-on workshops focused on the four modules of the **GreenEntre4Deaf Modularised Course**. Through practical activities and collaborative exercises, educators will have the opportunity to test learning materials, complete assessment activities linked to the project's **micro-credential system**, and exchange experiences on inclusive and accessible teaching practices.

The training programme will also introduce participants to the project's **Living Lab methodology**, which promotes co-creation, experimentation and stakeholder engagement as essential elements for developing innovative educational solutions.

Experiencing Learning Through Virtual Reality

One of the highlights of the mobility will be the testing of the project's **Virtual Reality (VR) Simulations**, which recreate a range of green entrepreneurship and sustainability-related work environments. Through hands-on activities, participants will explore the VR scenarios, assess their educational value and provide feedback to support the final refinement of these innovative learning tools.

Final Reflection and Evaluation

Following the completion of the mobility activities, participants will take part in a final **online evaluation session**, on **3 July 2026**, creating an opportunity to reflect on the learning experience, assess the effectiveness of the training programme and share recommendations for future implementation.

This final step will help ensure that the resources developed by **GreenEntre4Deaf** effectively support educators and trainers in promoting **green entrepreneurship, digital innovation, and inclusive lifelong learning opportunities** for Deaf and Hard of Hearing learners across Europe.
