Connect to KVK information systems*

*Log in details will be sent to your personal email address which you indicated while applying for studies.

As soon as you receive your access credentials (check the e-mail you indicated in your admissions application)

Register for the semester. You will need to do this every semester (www.moodle.kvk.lt – Students – Register for the Semester). At the top of the form, select 'English' as your preferred language.

Registration is open until 12 September
In spring semester – until 13 February

If you have studied at another higher education institution and want your results to be recognized, you must submit a request to your faculty administration.

Until 12 September

If you need a certificate** of study or a session attendance certificate, you can order it by logging in at www.moodle.kvk.lt → change the language to English in → Settings Students → Certificates and Applications.

Erasmus+ Exchange Programme for Students

The Erasmus+ programme offers students the opportunity to go abroad to a higher education institution or another organization for partial studies and/or traineeship. Each student can participate in a short-term (5–14 days) and long-term mobilities (2–12 months).

All students participating in the programme will receive an Erasmus+ grant. Additionally, KVK supports students with fewer opportunities by providing an additional fixed allowance. Students with physical, mental, or other disabilities may receive additional funding based on actual expenses incurred.

PARTICIPATION IS AVAILABLE FROM THE VERY FIRST YEAR OF STUDIES!

Why Participate in the Erasmus+ Programme?

- Gain international experience and professional knowledge.
- Improve foreign language skills and receive free language courses.
- Erasmus+ mobility will be included in the diploma supplement issued after graduation.
- Students who go on Erasmus+ mobility are not subject to academic ranking that year, so they do not lose scholarships.
- Erasmus+ alumni are twice as likely to find employment within a year of graduation.
- One-third of Erasmus+ interns receive job offers from the companies where they did their traineeship.
- Opportunity to learn about other cultures and make connections around the world.

To participate in the Erasmus+ programme, students must fill out an application form on the [kvk.lt](https://www.kvk.lt) website.

KVK students are also invited to join the Erasmus mentor team. These are volunteer students who help incoming international students integrate into life in Klaipėda.
