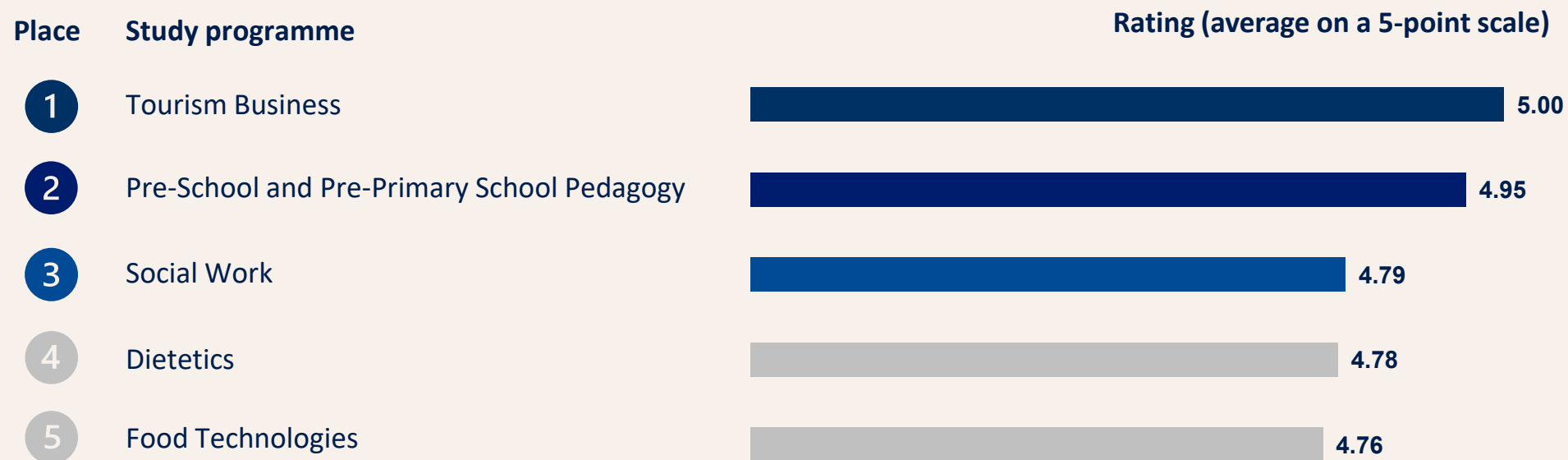

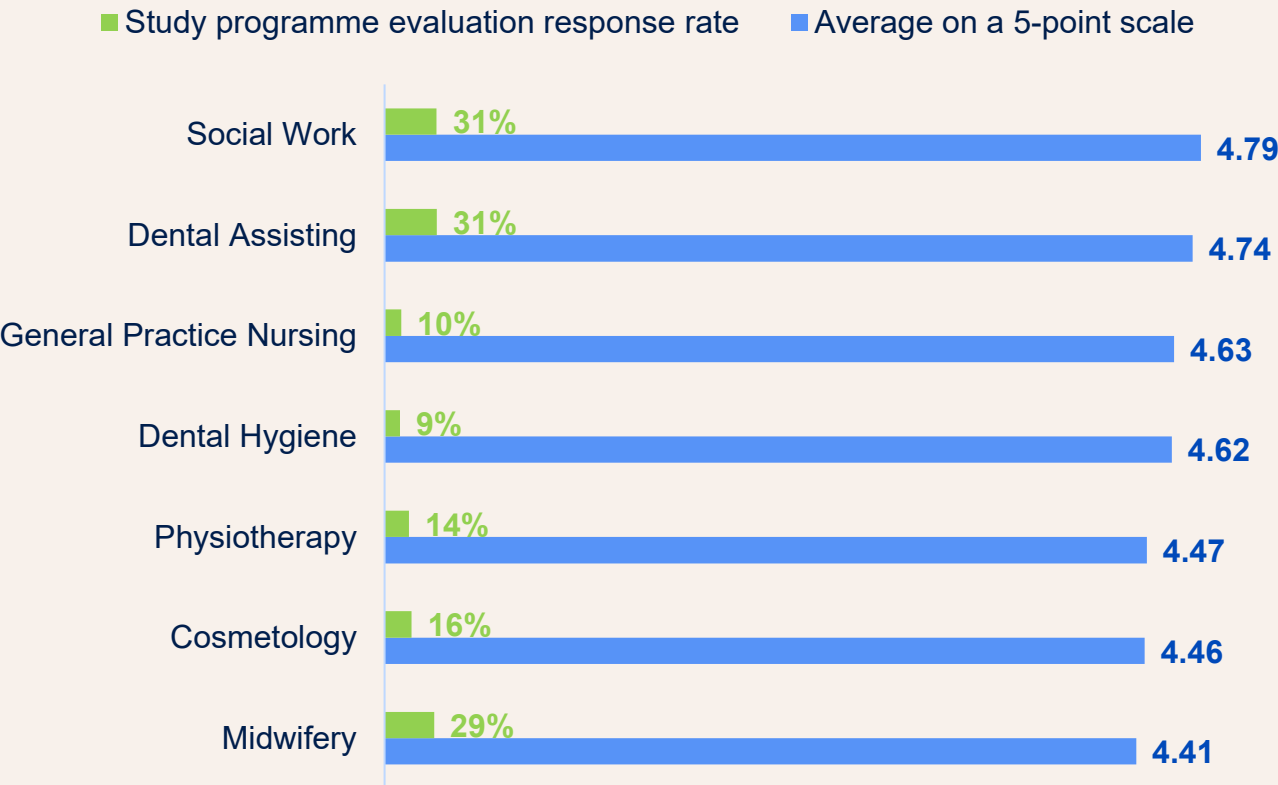

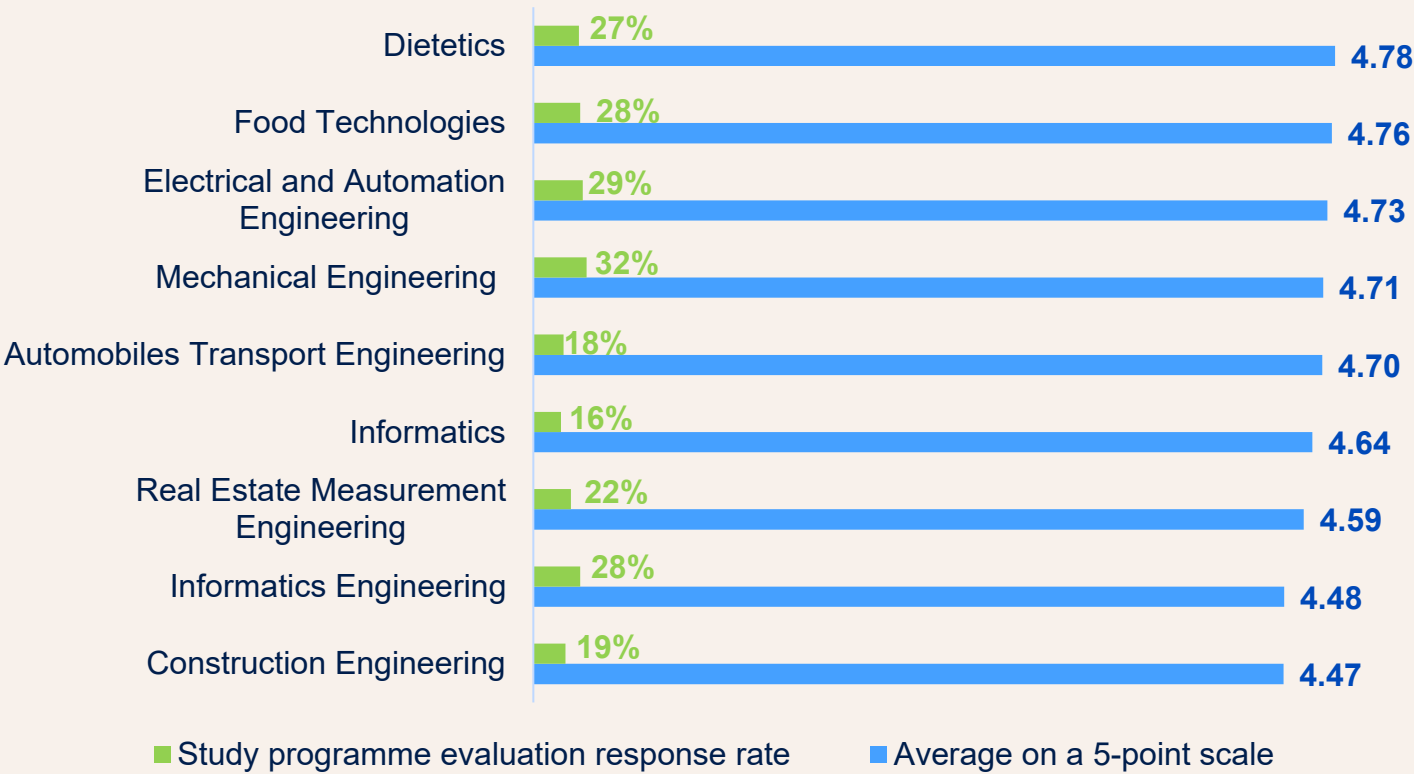

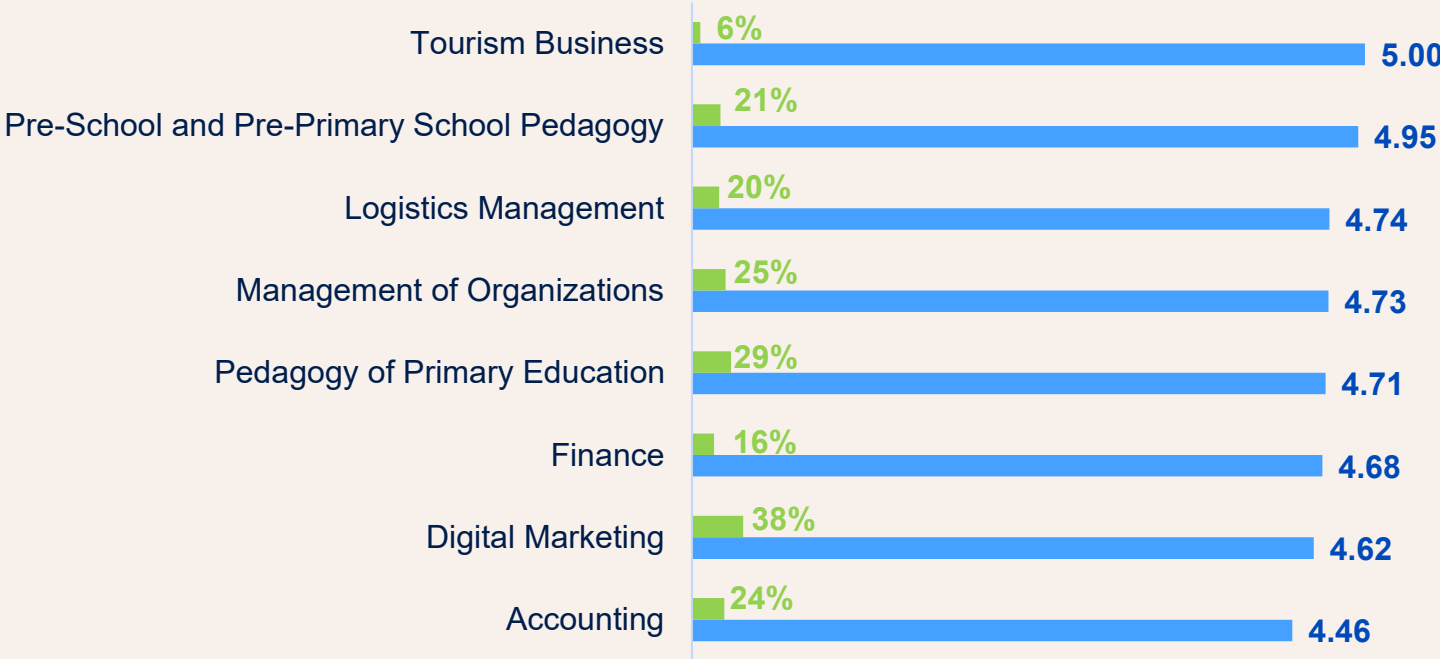

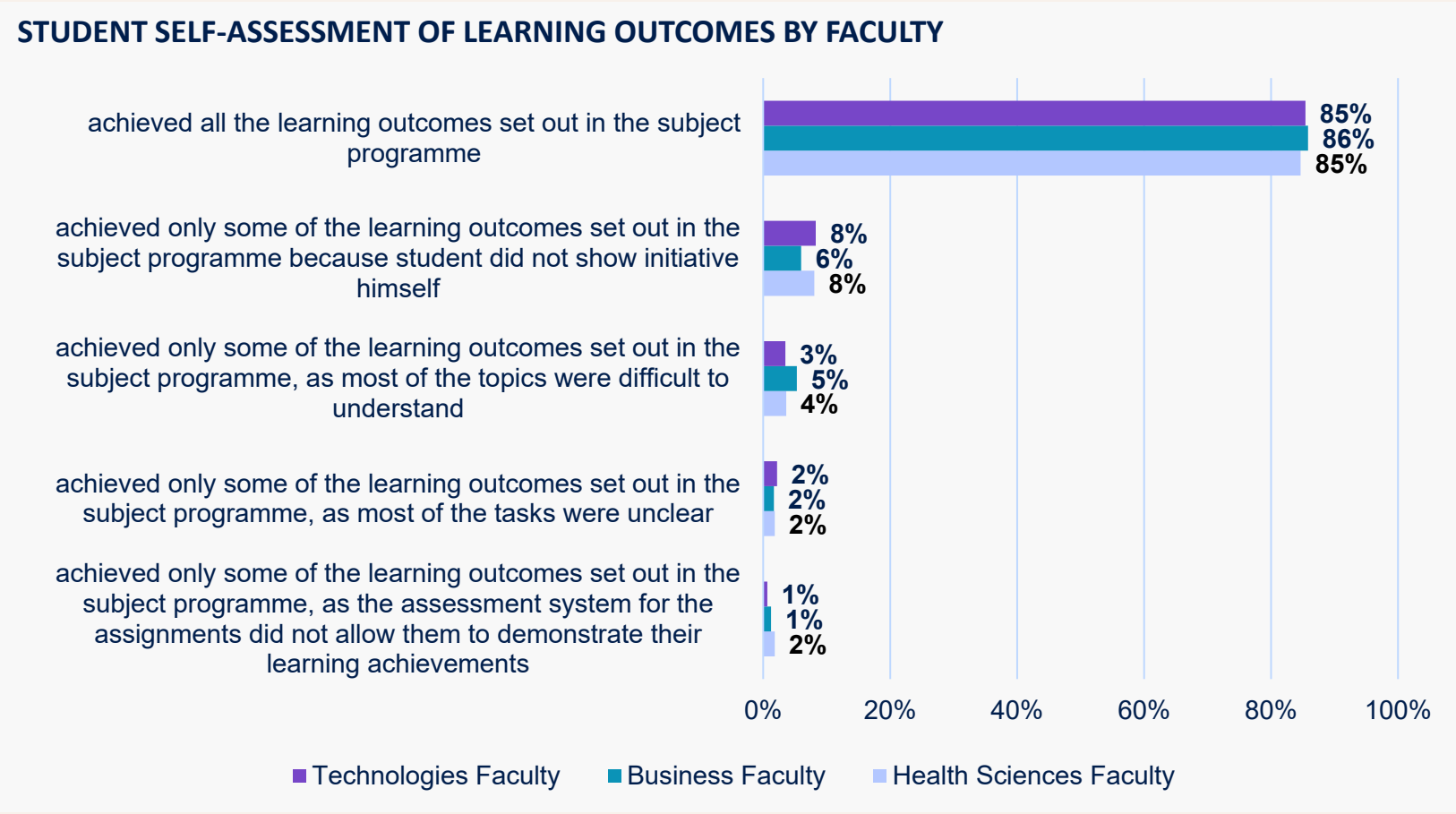

# STUDENTS ARE ACHIEVING THEIR STUDY RESULTS SUCCESSFULLY

Spring semester 2025–2026



86% of students at the Business Faculty, 85% at the Technologies Faculty and at the Health Sciences Faculty achieved all their learning outcomes.

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On average, 85% of KVK students achieved all the expected learning outcomes.

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On average, 7% of KVK students stated that they had achieved only some of their learning outcomes because they had not shown any initiative themselves.

To summarise the data collected, it can be said that, in the students’ opinion, **all KVK study programmes are rated with average marks higher than 4 (out of a possible 5)**. All the data collected and organised is forwarded to the relevant persons with a view to improving the quality of study.

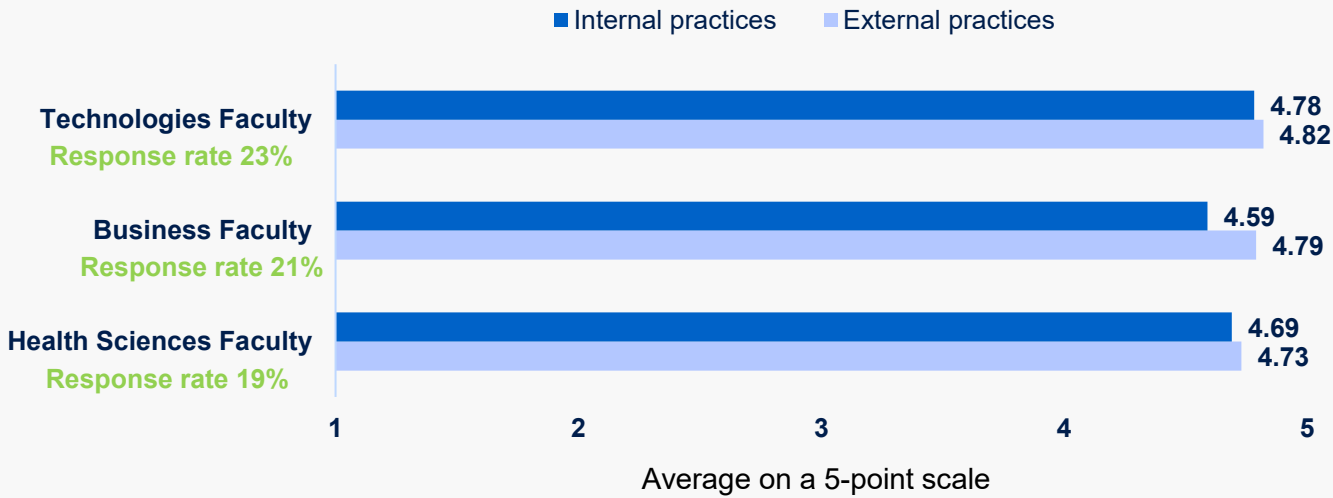

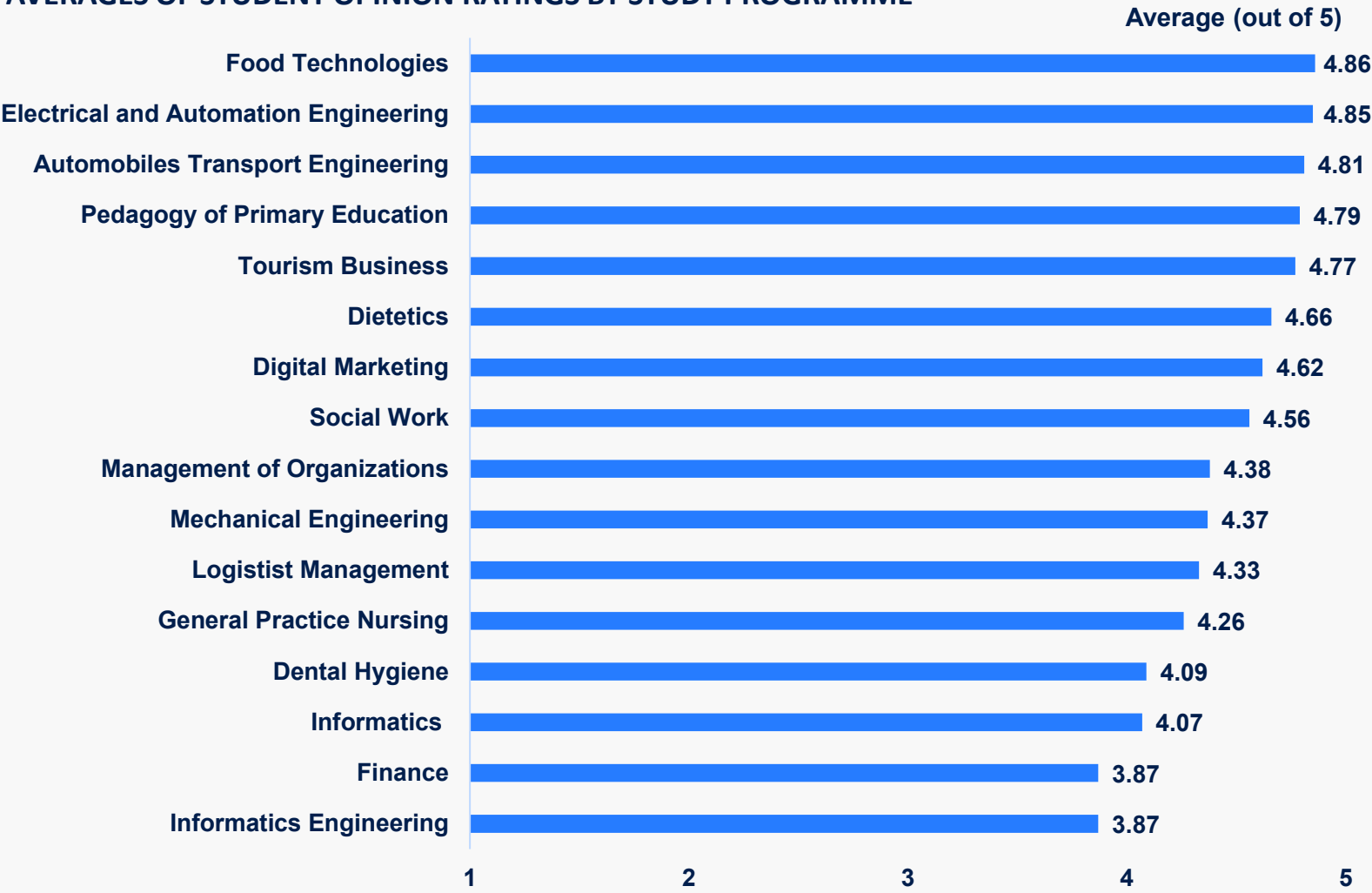


# ERASMUS+ STUDENTS' OPINION ABOUT THE STUDY OF THE SUBJECT
